

Tamanu Oil

Overview

Tamanu Oil is extracted from the *Calophyllum inophyllum* plant, a large evergreen tree found in the Mekong River Delta in Vietnam and the islands of Madagascar and Vanuatu. The tree thrives alongside tropical shores, where brackish water is present, and it takes approximately 1 – 2 months after germination before the seedling can be moved into full sunlight, where the plant can begin its lifecycle journey. Fruition occurs 4-5 years into growth, with year-round flowering thereafter. Tamanu Oil varies in color from pale yellow to dark green, possessing a robust, aromatic, nutty, and pecan-like fragrance.



Properties, benefits & uses

Tamanu seeds yield a prized "Green Gold" emollient oil rich in essential fatty acids (Omega-6 and Omega-9) and unique bioactive resins. This oil possesses therapeutic properties, including antioxidant qualities, sun protection factors, and antimicrobial activity against bacterial and fungal infections.
