This perennial crop is planted every eight years in May and harvested in July or August annually.

Our UK farmers, with over four generations of experience, extract essential oils. Roman Chamomile flowers typically yield 0.4%-1.0% essential oil, requiring 100-250kg of flowers for 1kg of oil. This English oil is highly regarded for its herbaceous, sweet, fruity scent with subtle hints of hay or tea leaves.
